RECIPE FROM 4/8 LODGE MEETING:

Tusen takk to *Carol Rogelstad* for sharing this recipe with us!

BRUN KAKE:

1 cup butter (butter works the best!)
1 cup white sugar
2 round tsp. Oetker's vanilla sockar (sugar)*
2 Tbsp. Lyle's Golden Syrup*
2 cups flour
1 tsp. soda

Cream butter and white sugar; add syrup and vanilla socker to creamed mixture.

Add flour and soda. The mixture is stiff.

Divide into 4 pieces; roll each section into a long roll the thickness of a fat hot dog. Put 2 rolls on an ungreased cookie sheet and flatten a little with a rolling pin lengthwise (I use my hands). It spreads while baking. Bake at 350 degrees for 15-20 minutes. Cut with a knife or a pizza cutter. Cool on rack.

* You can find both of these at HyVee. The vanilla sockar is in the baking aisle near the sugars, and the Lyle's is near the syrups.
