**College Scholarships - 2011**

**General Information**

1. S/N Kristiania Lodge 1-47 is offering four, college scholarships in the amount of \$500, to graduating seniors, and/or past recipients of a Kristiania Lodge college scholarship, who are sons, daughters, grandchildren, or great grandchildren of current Kristiania Lodge members and/or graduating seniors from public high schools in Olmsted County.
2. These scholarships will be awarded to graduating high school seniors who will be pursuing post high school education in the fall of 2011, or past recipients of a Kristiania scholarship who have successfully completed their first semester of college and are reapplying.
3. Once the Kristiania Scholarship Committee has chosen the recipients, they will be notified by mail and information will be gathered from their university, college, community college, or technical school regarding their enrollment. Applicants who were not selected, will also be notified by mail.
4. Scholarship recipients and their parents/guardians will be invited to attend a Kristiania Lodge meeting on Thursday, May 12, at 7:00 p.m.
5. Scholarship information will be available in each public high school in Olmsted County, by February 1, 2011. Check with your high school guidance counselor. 6. Restrictions and/or limitations are noted in the attached scholarship application form.
7. The selection committee of Kristiania Lodge 1-47 will review all applications and notify, by mail, both selected and non-selected recipients by May 1, 2011.

At the beginning of the fall college term and with verification of enrollment, Kristiania Lodge will issue a check payable to the financial aid office and/or cashier along with a letter indicating the recipient of the award. No money will be directly awarded to the recipient. If for any reason the student does not fulfill his/her obligation to the institution, the monies must be returned to Kristiania Lodge.
